## MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Development of the MCSF 60-83

- 1. FL-444 has determined that the CAPF 60-83 "Weekly Squadron Meeting Planner" is not meeting the needs of the squadron during the 2023 SUI. Times allotted to each functional area are not clearly denoted.
- 2. The created form, Marianna Composite Squadron Form (MCSF) 60-83 "Bi-Weekly Squadron Meeting Planner", will indicate the draft revision, contain five (5) training blocks, the drafter's name, and the approving authority if not the FL444/CC or the FL444/CDC.
- 3. The MCSF 60-83 may either compliment the CAPF 60-83 or serve stand-alone if only one form is needed. Use of the MCSF 60-83 will not apply to other squadrons.
- 4. For purposes of members enrolled in the Cadet Programs specialty track, those members will still need to complete at least one (1) CAPF 60-83 for their training. The MCSF 60-83 is not intended to, and will not, serve as substitute for that training requirement.
- 5. Any member may fill and submit the MCSF 60-83, but only the FL444/CC or a duly appointed Deputy Commander can approve the form. In a dispute between Deputy Commanders (if multiple Deputy Commanders are appointed) on approval: the FL444/CDC's decision will overrule that of the FL444/CDS, or the FL444/CC may make the final decision.
- 6. Each training block must be denoted with a functional area (i.e. Safety, Character Development), topic (i.e. Hydration, Core Values), Lead instructor, a start time, and end time.
- 7. IAW CAPR 60-1, the MCSF 60-83 should be filled and submitted at least one week prior to the meeting in the same manner prescribed for the CAPF 60-83.
- 8. IAW CAPR 1-2, this Memorandum for Record and the newly-created MCSF 60-83 will be published to the unit website immediately. These items will be located under "MEMBERS" >> "PUBLICATIONS" >> "FORMS".
